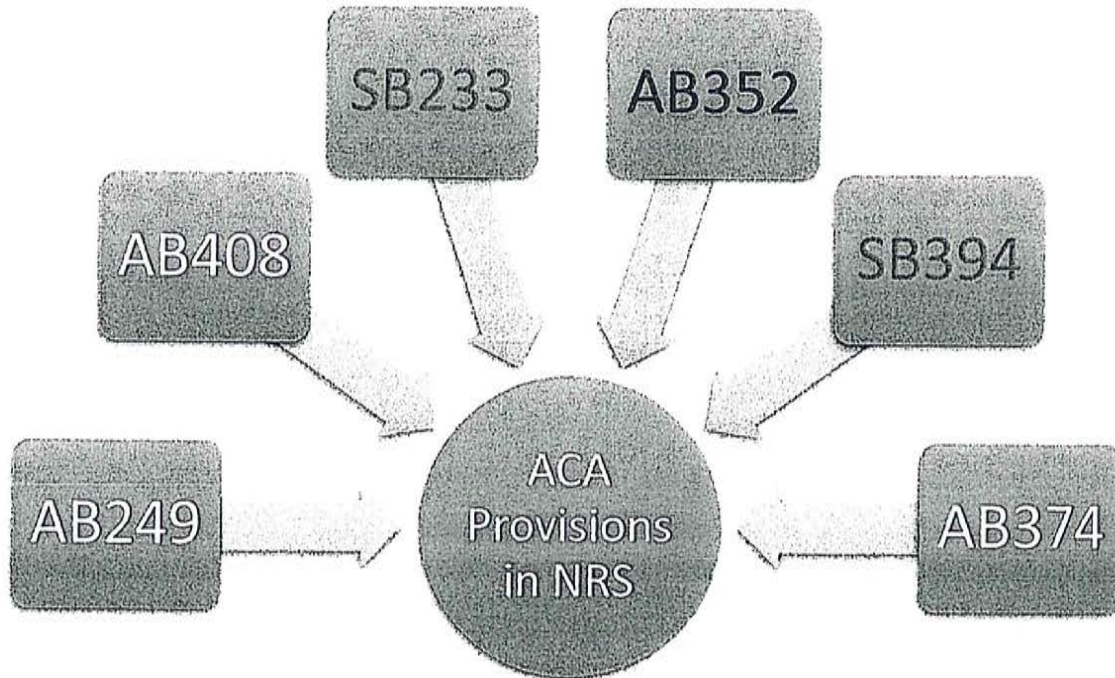

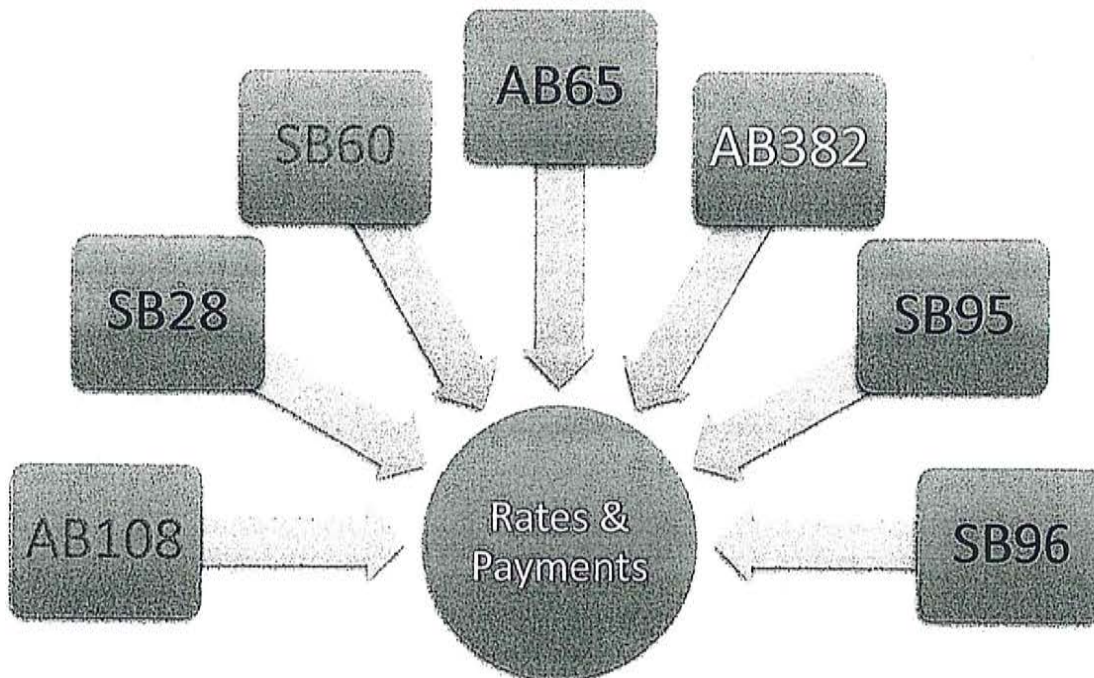
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## Health Access



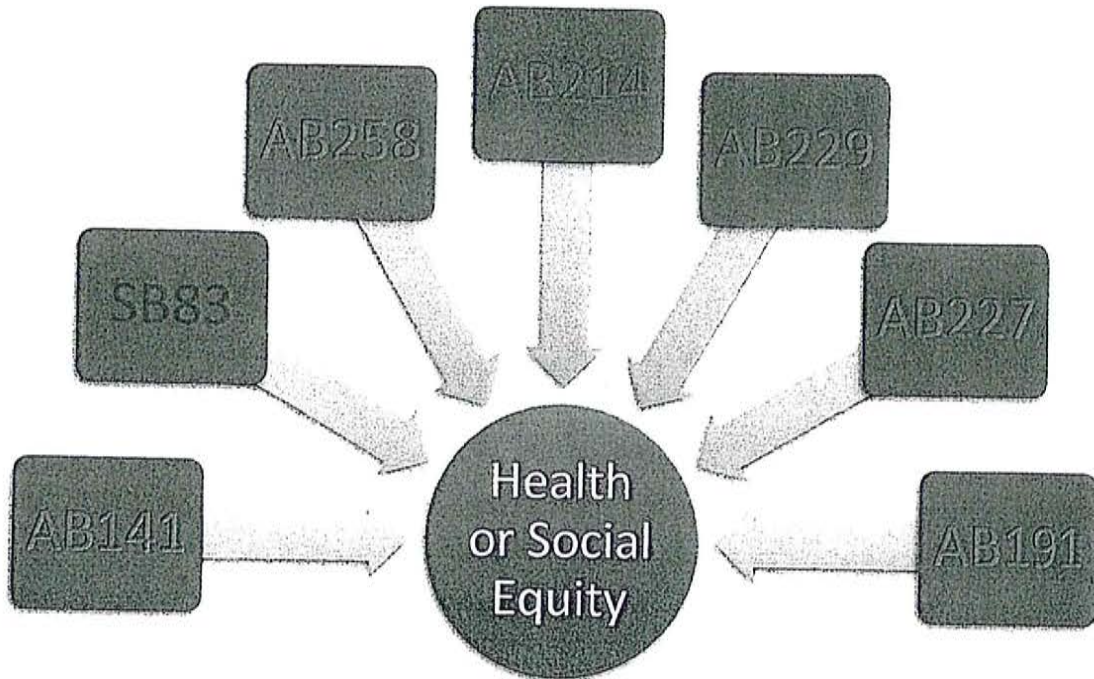
Assemblyman Sprinkle is a primary sponsor on AB249, AB408, and AB374. SB394 and AB374 both require Medicaid to offer the managed care plan on the exchange, but use slightly different language with regard to premium cost and SB394 includes additional provisions related to other ACA requirements. The language of all of these bills seeks to codify ACA language into NRS.



Many of these bills were initiated from interim committee meetings and request rate reviews or analysis (SB28, SB60, AB65, SB95, SB96). AB108 also requests a rate review but has Oscarson as a primary sponsor.

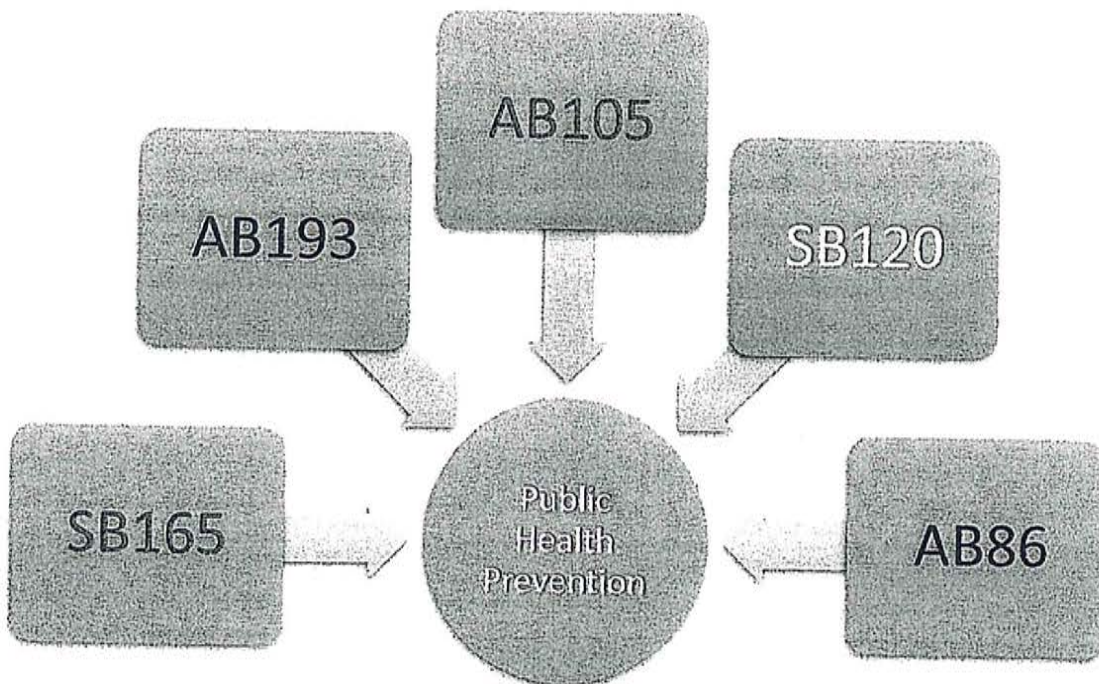


## Minority Health and Equity



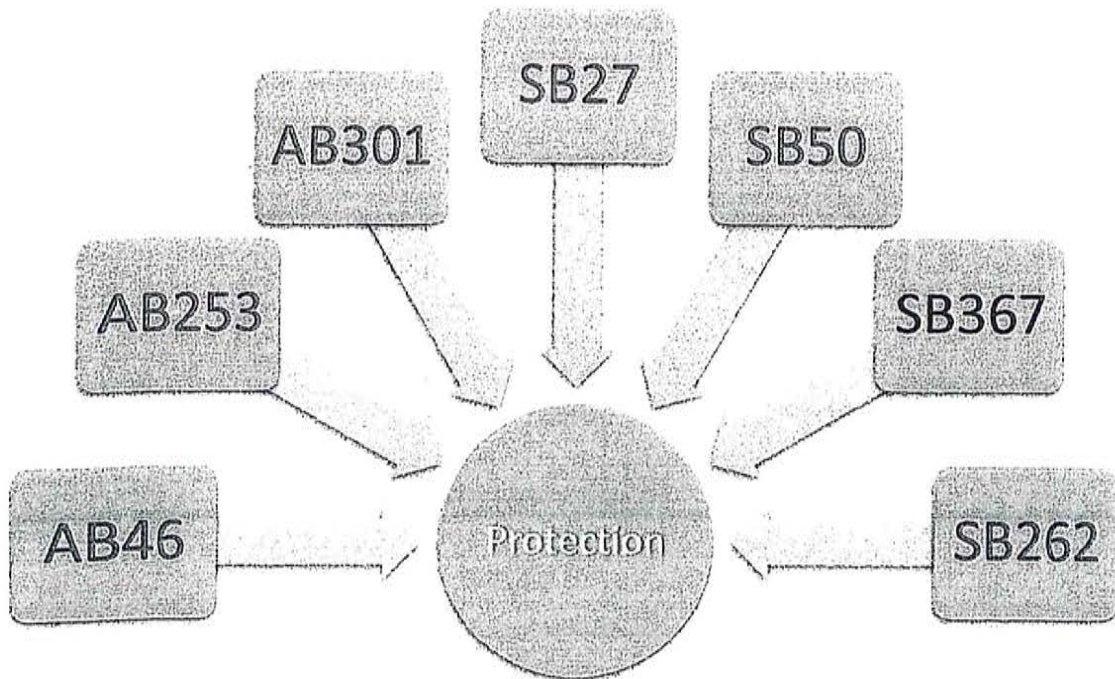
Carrillo is a primary sponsor on the majority of these bills (AB229, AB227, AB141, AB258, SB201). They cover some variety of subject matter, but are all focused on ensuring health or social equity for a minority group.

## Public Health



Each of these bills targets a specific health issue or disease (e.g. obesity or fluoride) and there is no commonality among bill sponsors.

## Mental Health



There appeared to be a desire to provide better protection to the public, consumers of services, and providers with relation to mental or behavioral health services. SB177 and SB27 specifically attempt to define the term mental illness. The remaining bills are sponsored by a variety of legislators. There is not a tremendous amount of cross over in these bills and several of them (SB27, SB50, and AB46) were sponsored by committees.

## Substance Use



Senator Farley is the sponsor of two of the bills (SB166, SB159) that seek to protect and educate children with regard to drug and alcohol abuse.
