SB283 – being heard tomorrow at 1pm health and human services – bill about how medications get onto formularies

SB235 – pre- existing conditions ACA expands for mental health

AB66 – Hearing was a week ago – a lot of positive testimony. Crisis stabilization facility -Regional Policy Board worked on amendment – work session is tomorrow April 10.

SB37 – mft /cpc board of examiners bill – waited amended language.

SB247 – consent for parent’s guardians – senator Pickard holding stakeholder session to get feedback

AB 129 –

AB76 – create regional policy boards into employees

AB85- due pass as amended

SB194 – financial literacy for foster children

AB474 – additional training for people dispensing opioids
