**Agenda Item #1 Dorothy Edwards MOST Team**

Mobile outreach safety team. Created in response to RPD need to intervene with SMI folks on RPD calls. The State funds mental health resources and MOST. Clark County has a MOST team that rides with fire and EMS. Reno team is 6 clinicians. Ride with Sparks and Reno PD. 7 days a week but not 24/7 yet (no graveyard yet) exploring that for the future. The calls are happening mostly during swing shift, so they are going to add a second swing shift soon. Goals are early intervention. Mitigate hospital stays and jail diversion. Impact reduction (reduction in law enforcement calls). Connect with resources, support networks. Improve public safety. Clinicians ride with law enforcement. Calls come from dispatch, HAS, crisis call, family members, public, website. MOST does not pretend to be law enforcement; they are brothers and sisters with law enforcement. The majority of officers want MOST with them on calls. Only one MOST worker on duty at a time. They respond to calls such as jumpers, suicide calls, domestic violence, etc. MOST does not get in the way of officer. All MOST workers are currently women. MOST can do legal holds if they need to. There is a member of the team responsible for follow up. The majority of cases have a co-occurring disorder (substance use and mental health). RPD has a van two days a week to help with carrying items such as food, feminine hygiene, personal hygiene. Continued funding through state for MOST team, adding two new workers.

Community health alliance- how do we manage multiple care coordination with patients? HPN works closely with the care coordinator at CHA.

Care providers should ask patients who have HPN, do you have someone who is coordinating care already? If not, call the HPN number and get set up with care coordination.

Value added for HPN means services that are not covered by traditional Medicaid. Housing, food, transportation (other than MTM), clothing. Trying to close the gaps.

Services are just for HPN Medicaid clients.

Providers need to be state Medicaid approved.

All case management services are provided by HPN employees. They also have peers and CHW on staff. Contracted with HBI and NBH to provide services.

AB 85 with Gov for sig – legal holds

AB66 –going to workgroup in senate, looks like fiscal note will be removed.

AB76 – add 5ht regional coordinator. Passed work session this week. Should be passing senate

AB47 -Rural bill CIT training and transportation. Siting in ways and means. Will prob go through at last minute

SB37 – probably set for work session tomorrow.

Don Butterfield – launching eating disorder specialty program (in patient adult only to start). Local residential facility that closed 6 weeks ago. (Center for hopes of sierra). Treating eating disorders and co-occurring.
